Physical Education

The Physical Education program provides a range of experiences for students. Prep students perform basic motor skills and movement patterns, with or without equipment, in a range of environments. The focus is on skills such as running, jumping, skipping, catching, throwing, kicking, balancing and are introduced to more complex skills such as leaping, dodging, overarm throw, dribbling, bouncing and striking.

Art

Artistic achievement is learning how to bring together diverse elements and principles into a cohesive art work. For this to take place a plethora of different kinds of thinking and feelings need to melt together to form a whole. For some people, artistic talents come naturally, however, for most of us we rely on thinking strategies to discover what we do not intuitively know.

We provide a rich environment that allows 'learning by doing', 'opportunities for spontaneity' and a safe environment that is tolerant and conducive to 'risk taking'. The children and teachers are challenged to problem solve, provoke further questioning and stretch their thinking as we all learn and grow together.





Japanese

Prep students participate in Japanese lessons at Lake Clarendon State School. The focus is on cultural understanding, as well as being introduced to simple language. Students participate in activities that encourage an understanding of Japanese culture and language. The Japanese program is taught by a Japanese language teacher with the support of classroom teacher aides.
